## **The Sonoma County Human Services Department & The Employment Group can help!**



The Employment Group is looking for eligible job seekers to place into newly created jobs through the Subsidized Employment Program (SEP). SEP, funded through the Federal Stimulus Program and by the Sonoma County Human Services Department, will pay employers all or part of your wages for 3 to 6 months! If you need a great job, call today!

### **Eligibility**

To participate, you must meet 4 basic criteria:

1. Be a resident of Sonoma County
2. Have at least one minor child (even if you do not live with that child)
3. Show proof of right to work
4. Have income less than 200% of the federal poverty level (see table).

### **Available Jobs**

There are a wide range of job types available through SEP. Based on your work experience, you will be matched with a job that's right for you.

### **Wages And Schedule**

All SEP jobs pay at least minimum wage, which is currently \$8.00 per hour. Most jobs will pay between \$10-\$15 per hour. The majority of SEP jobs will be full-time, though there are opportunities for those interested in part-time work.
