Program Description

As part of the ARRA Federal Stimulus Program, local non-profit and public non-profit employers can grow their organizations by participating in the Subsidized Employment Program (SEP). Under this program, the non-profit employer will be able to fill needed positions without accruing any wage expenses.

Program Dates

The program is available until September 2010. We encourage employers to retain their trained and competent SEP participants as regular employees after the wage subsidy ends.

How it Works

Non-profit and public non-profit employers place their job order with SEP staff, who will pre-screen eligible job seekers to match your organization needs. You get the new employee your non-profit requires, and a Sonoma County resident starts to work again – it's a win-win!
